Student Contract for the China Trip

I _____, agree as 'student' to the following terms and conditions:

1. Student will pay \$5,500 (USD) for the total cost of the China Trip.
2. Student must submit a non-refundable deposit of \$500 with all application materials or application will not be accepted. The deposit secures a China Visa and Both Air International and China Domestic Bookings. These fees are non-refundable once applied.
3. Student will pay the remaining cost of \$5,000 when the financial aid arrives. To pay the \$5,000 in two installments submit a written request with you application. Specify the reason for the payment plan and the dates your payments will be made. The final payment must be received no later than September 10.
4. Price includes the following: Round-trip airfare from Honolulu to China; Transportation within China (not including tips for drivers and guides); accommodations for the duration of the trip; three meals a day (does not include meals student chooses to eat other than those provided by the group facilitator); admission into all group activities scheduled by the group facilitator.
5. Any drinks or food other than what is provided by the group facilitator with the designated meal is the financial responsibility of the student. No alcohol will be included in the cost of any meal during the trip. It is the responsibility of the student to monitor their food and beverage intake. Ask the group facilitator if uncertain about a food or beverage item.
6. Airfare is not negotiable. If the student wishes to make extra travel arrangements outside those included in the China Trip package they will do so on their own. All extra expenses will be the responsibility of the students and no discounts will be given for students not using either the Honolulu to China departure ticket or the China to Honolulu return ticket.
7. Cancellation deadline: The initial \$500 deposit is used for Visa fees agent fees and other China trip deposits and is non-refundable. To receive a full refund on the remaining \$5,000 student must cancel before July 15. If the student cancels after July 15 they will be refunded \$4,500. If the student has not yet paid the \$5,000, they will owe World Medicine Institute \$500 (in addition to the initial \$500 deposit paid with the application). All airline tickets and China accommodations will be reserved around July 15 and the additional \$500 will cover the cancellation costs charged by the airline and Hotels.
8. WMI is not responsible for plane delays, loss of luggage, or missing personal items during the trip. Further WMI is not responsible for covering any medical costs for personal consultations, medical exams, treatments, or medications. Students are encouraged to secure their own medical coverage for the China trip.

I understand and agree that the above term 'student' refers to me whether I am a current student of WMI or not. I have read and agree to the above terms and conditions. I understand that my application will not be accepted without the \$500 deposit and that this deposit is non-refundable. I agree to pay the remaining \$5,000 by July 15. I agree to pay \$500, in addition to the \$500 deposit, if I cancel after July 15.
